DIRECTOR OF RESTORATIVE JUSTICE SERVICES **Half-Time Position (17.5 hours per week)**

Shalem Mental Health Network is seeking an experienced Restorative Justice practitioner to serve as our Director of Restorative Justice Services.

The successful candidate has the vision, leadership style and entrepreneurial skills needed to develop and expand the Restorative Justice component of Shalem's overall work. Preferably, you have a Master's degree in the field, a minimum of three years of restorative practice experience, and a demonstrated ability to build and sustain community partnerships. An ability to articulate an integrated approach to faith and restorative justice is essential.

As the Director of Restorative Services, you will provide:

- development and management of the multi-faith Hosting Project, in which faith communities act as the "hosts" of community-based restorative circles
- development and management of Faith CARE (Communities Affirming Restorative Experiences), a service for faith communities wishing to embrace restorative practices, including resourcing the broad-based community Steering Group which oversees Faith CARE
- orientation, training and coaching support for schools and school boards
- with partners, ongoing articulation of best practices
- support for embedding restorative practices within the culture and processes of Salem

Salary range for the position is \$30,000 to \$35,000, plus expenses and a full benefit package. The position is half-time, with the hours themselves and the location of the work being flexible. Access to a vehicle is essential. The position is a two-year contract position; if the program is successful, Shalem is committed to making the position permanent.
